<p>Immersion</p> <p>Start a class discussion about photos:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Who takes digital photos? Who has seen a photo of themselves on their parents' phone? How do we share those photos with others? 	<p>Manage privacy of self by recognising that online environments often ask for information that should remain private, and asking permission of a trusted adult before sharing.</p>	<p>Activity</p> <p>Whole Class (F – 2):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teach the concept of plus, minus, interesting point to the class. Then, ask them to brainstorm with you all the pluses about digital photos and sharing them – and why it is good. Then do the same with the minuses You might be able to redirect some responses into interesting points, or ask at the end if they want to add anything else. <p>Small groups (3 – 4):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do the same as above, but in small groups. 	<p>Share and discuss</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have students say whether they think sharing photos is a good idea? Then, work together to write a list of questions or rules for when it is good to share and when you shouldn't share.
